1. Background

Population, Health and Environment (PHE) approach acknowledge and address the complex connections between humans, their health, and their environment. The aim of integrating Population Health and Environment is to simultaneously improve health status of the community while also helping communities manage their natural resources. Ethio Wetlands and Natural Resources Association (EWNRA) has signed project agreement with the PHE Ethiopia Consortium to implement PHE integration project in Metu and Hurumu woredas of Illu Aba Bora zone. - The objective of the stakeholders analysis is to identify the relevant group of stakeholders from government Offices, civil society organizations, others and depict the clear picture of the stakeholders and show strategic directions how they influence the implementation of the project at Metu and Hurumu woredas.

3. Scope of Work

In order to achieve the above objective, the consultant is expected to carry out the following tasks:

- a. Design and deliver a household survey to determine the project beneficiaries’ social, economic, demographic and environmental situations.
- b. The consultant is expected to conduct stakeholders analysis

4. Methodology

The consultant is expected to present clear methodology to produce the quantitative and qualitative results of the baseline survey and stakeholder analysis. Data will be drawn from four project kebeles in Metu and Hurumu Woredas and control woredas of Yayu and Nopa. The stakeholders’ analysis will be carried out in the two project Woredas and at Zonal level. The survey is required to include at least 50% women respondents.

- a. The Baseline analysis report of Metu and Hurumu implementation kebeles and the control kebeles in Yayu and Nopa woredas.
- b. Stakeholders analysis report of the implementation kebeles, Metu and Hurumu woredas and Ilu Ababora zone
